

### WANT MORE WOMEN IN GOVERNMENT?



Number of PEI MLA's by gender<sup>1</sup>

- Men 81.5%



## NOMINATE MORE WOMEN CANDIDATES

Islanders do not discriminate against women at the polls but women's names need to be on the ballot in the first place. A 30 year average of party nomination and election data from general elections shows women have been elected in proportion with nominations.<sup>2</sup>

The Green Party and New Democratic Party have had good success nominating women candidates but have not elected a woman MLA in a general election. (A woman MLA representing the Green Party was nominated and elected in a 2017 by election.)

### #3 Support A Candidate!


Visit news sites and party websites for information on who is running for nomination




#### #4 Vote!


Attend the nomination meeting and vote for the candidate of your choice.
